

Timothy Smith

Timothy J Smith was born in 1832 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died March 1, 1869 at Silver Point, Dekalb County, Tennessee. His death date was found on his tombstone application (Civil War Stone). It states he was buried in Buffalo Valley cemetery at Silver Point, Tennessee. He was a son of Thomas Jefferson Smith (1806-?) of Tennessee and Matilda Puckett (about 1813-1884) of White County, Tennessee.

On November 21, 1850 in Dekalb County, Tennessee he married Elizabeth Parsley. She was a daughter of John Parsley (1792-about 1840) of Adair County, Kentucky and Frances Isbell (1792-1852) of Wilkes County, North Carolina. Elizabeth Parsley was born in 1827 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Her death date is unknown, but she filed an application for Timothy Smith's pension on July 18, 1890.

Timothy Smith joined the Union Army, enlisting in Company L, 1st Tennesse Mounted Infantry Regiment on August 1, 1864 and was mustered in on January 7, 1865 when the war was almost over.

Their children were Marinda (1852), Alexander (1854), Angeline (1855), William (1857) and Hattie (1858).

Timothy was interred at D T Puckett cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at the disinterment.
