

Tiny Henley

Tiny Henley was likely a child of Farris Whitson Henley (August 5, 1875-May 14, 1966

Putnam Co., TN) and Mary Hayes. Mary Hayes died in 1904, probably in childbirth of another son, George Henley.

Mary Hayes was the first wife of Farris Henley. He was the son of Amon D Henley (1852-?) and Malinda A Herren (about 1850-?). Farris Henley married Mary Hayes on April 16, 1896. When Mary died he married twice more, to Nettie Pack and to Mary Herren in 1919. He was buried in Henley cemetery in Putnam County, Tennessee.

Mary Henley was buried in Puckett cemetery in Dekalb County, Tennessee with George and Tiny. Her parents are unknown.

She and Farris had two other children, Jay E (1898) and Jinnie E (1900).

Tiny Henley, along with his brother George and his mother Mary were disinterred at Puckett cemetery and were relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at Tiny's disinterment.
