



W M & Sarah (Cantrell) Pack

William Matthew Pack was born August 15, 1838 in Dekalb County, Tennessee, and died December 27, 1910 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the son of John Pack (1816-1862) who was killed in the Civil War, and Maria Hayes (1817-before 1856). John and Maria Pack were from Warren County, Tennessee.

William M Pack also fought in the Civil War for the Confederacy in Company C 35th Tennessee Infantry Regiment. He attained the rank of Sergeant.

On December 9, 1867 he married Sarah Cantrell in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was born July 21, 1837 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died December 31, 1917 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Abraham Cantrell (about 1780) of Spartanburg, South Carolina and Emily Wade (about 1798) of North Carolina.

William and Sarah Pack had the following children, two of which were named for Confederate Generals: John W (1860) Packrick Cleburne (1870), Millie F (1872), Felix Zollicoffer (1873) and Nancy C (1877).

They were interred at Heirs of Martha Pack cemetery and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. One of their sons, Felix Zollicoffer was present at their disinterment.
