



William A Hallum

William A Hallum was born July 9, 1844 and died December 31, 1862 as a result of wounds received at the Battle of Murfreesboro or Stones River. He was a private in Company A, 16th Tennessee Infantry Regiment, Colonel John H Savage commanding.

He was the son of John T Hallum (1811-1899) and Frances Stinson (1817-1883). He was 18 years of age when he was killed.

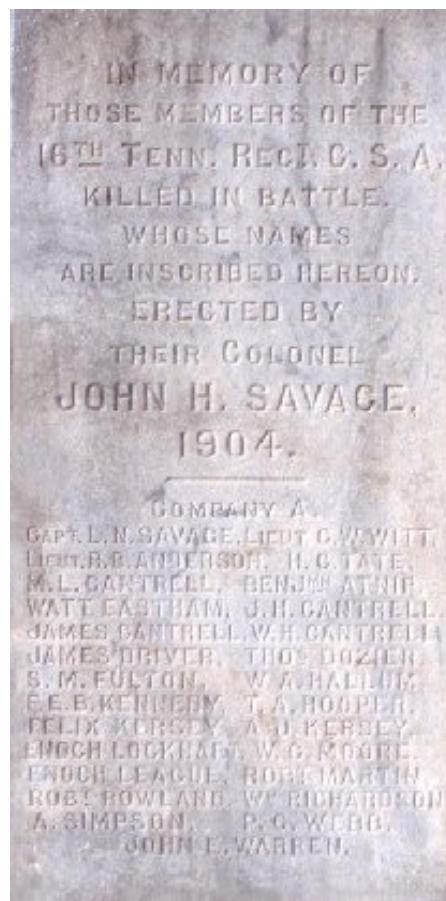
He was disinterred from John Hallum Heirs cemetery and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. There was noone present at his disinterment.
