

William Carroll Vanhooser

William Carroll Vanhooser was born April 24, 1860 in Warren County, Tennessee and died March 14, 1920 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the son of Sampson O Vanhooser (1826-186?) and Nancy Elizabeth Cantrell (1831-?) of Warren County, Tennessee. Sampson Vanhooser was killed in the Civil War on October 21, 1863.

On September 9, 1880 he married Louisianna Atnip in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was born November 1, 1862 in Smith County, Tennessee and died February 22, 1887 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of John Esau Atnip (1825-1901) and Mary Clark (1831-1887). When Louisianna died in 1887 he married Mary Cantrell on August 7, 1887. She was born in November 1869 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died 1948 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.

William and Louisianna had two children: Mary Elizabeth (1882) and Zollie Coffer (1883).

He and Mary Cantrell had a larger family: John (1889), Stanton (1891), Nancy E (1892), Herman (1896), and Clara (1900).

William Carroll and Louisianna were interred at Helen F Conger cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. A niece, Mrs L P Womack was present.
