

William Fuson Dyer

William Fuson Dyer was born August 22, 1880 and died January 5, 1951. He was a son of John Henry B Dyer (1856-1889) of Dekalb County, Tennessee and Elisabeth Steele (about 1857-1898) of Tennessee.

On August 26, 1906 he married Daisy Ella Eastham in Bozarth, Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was born January 24, 1886 at Falling Waters, Dekalb County, Tennessee and died February 16, 1956 at Smithville, Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Henry Eastham (1837-1923) and Nancy Emma Cantrell (1859-?) of Tennessee.

They were a Silver Point family. William was a Rural Route Mail Carrier. Their children were Henry (1908), Helen (1909), Jack O (1914), W F (1918) and Gamaliel (1921).

Their original place of burial was uncertain, so they were listed as "Miscellaneous." From their first burial site they were exhumed and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at their disinterment.
