

William Harrison Tramel

William Harrison Tramel was born June 26, 1834 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died October 20, 1889 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of Dennis Tramel (1814-1894) and Nancy Botts (1810-1880). He married twice; first to Mary Jane Hullett (1835-1865) and upon her death he married in the same year on October 1,1865 Louisa Elizabeth McIntyre who was born on July 7, 1843 and died in 1906. They were married in Dekalb County, Tennesssee.

The children of William H and Louisa E were: William Grant (1866), Mary Elizabeth (1867), James Dennis (1870), Tennessee (1872), Jackson Milton (1875), Winket Alexander (1876), and Cora Frances (1878).

In the Civil War William H Tramel served in the Union Army as Corporal, Company K, 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment, Middle Tennessee Cavalry which later became Company K, 5<sup>th</sup> Regiment, Tennessee Cavalry. He was promoted to Sergeant on June 27, 1864.

He was disinterred from K C Tramel cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was present at the disinterment.
