



William Marion Hailes & Mary (Coggin) Hailes

William M Hailes was born May 2, 1820 in Smith County, Tennessee and died November 21, 1859. He was a son of Linton Hailes (1779-1849) and Jennie Wright (1781-1840). The 1860 U S Federal Census Mortality Schedule gives William's cause of death as "Disease of Liver."

His wife, Mary W Coggin (1823-?) was born June 22, 1823. Her death date was never entered on the monument. She died after 1910. There is a Dekalb Co., TN death certificate for a "Mary M. Hale, died January 4, 1911, living in the Laurel Hill area, age 87 (therefore born about 1823), which should be her. In the 1910 census, Mary was living with her son, "Linton Hale" in district 16 of DeKalb Co., TN, which is Laurel Hill. It's fairly certain this is the right death certificate for her. She was the daughter of Jerremiah Coggin (1798-1874) and Mary Ann Nancy Osborne (1823-aft 1910).

Their children were: Mary A. (b. May 8, 1851), William Riley (1841), Mary Jane (1841), James M. (1843), Martha Elizabeth (1845), Jeremiah (1848), Susan A. (1854), Linton (1856), Missillana W. (1859). Of these 4 died as infants and shared this same stone: Mary A. (d. July 30, 1852) William Riley (d. 1842), Mary Jane (d. 1842), and Susan A. (d. 1855).

They were buried at Jerrimah Coggin Heirs Cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at their disinterment.

Of these children the following are not listed as buried at Mount Holly:

(1) Martha Elizabeth Hailes married J. M. Butler on Dec. 2, 1865 in DeKalb Co., TN. She was without a husband in 1870 and living with her widowed mother, and she had two children:

- William Butler (1867) [the same person buried here in Mt Holly Cemetery as "W. L. Butler" Jan. 23, 1867-Feb. 17, 1899].

- Mary C. Butler (b. 1869)

(2) Jeremiah Hailes

(3) "Miscellaney" Hailes married T. H. Starnes Dec. 19, 1876 in DeKalb Co., TN.
