



**William Riley Hill**

**William Riley Hill was born March 10, 1835 and died March 29, 1890 at 55 years of age in Dekalb County, Tennessee. His parents have not been identified.**

**On August 28, 1855 he married Mary Elizabeth Tramel, daughter of Shadrick Tramel (1806-1876) and Elizabeth McIntyre (1808-1888). She was born June 17, 1838 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died August 11, 1884 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.**

**They had only one daughter, Julia Cantrell Fuson born September 28, 1874 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.**

**William Riley contracted rheumatism during his service in the Civil War. He served in Company E, 4<sup>th</sup> Regiment, Tennessee Mounted Infantry.**

**Perhaps this is why his tombstone reads:**

**“May he rest in peace, amen.”**

**He was disinterred from K C Tramel cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was present at his disinterment.**
