**There is in the Union records of the Civil War a Green Berry Pedigo who attained the rank of Corporal and served in Co. K of the 5th Tennessee Cavalry (Union). This is the only Civil War soldier having the surname of Pedigo that even comes close to fitting what is on this stone.**

**Green Berry was born July 1837, the son of Moses Pedigo, b. VA, and married Virginia Foster (May 1840 DeKalb, TN- March 3, 1924 DeKalb, TN), daughter of Eps Foster, b. VA, and Unknown Webster, b. VA, on December 9, 1868 in DeKalb Co., TN. He died between 1900 and 1910. Their 2 children by 1900 were: Elija G. born February 1871, and Sarah E. born October 1871. Virginia lived with her son Elija after the death of her husband, Green Berry.**
