To all who shall see these Presents:

GREETING.

Know ye That we do hereby COMMISSION
John H. Trent of the County of Hamock
Captain in Company A
in the First Regiment of East Tennessee Cavalry of the
Force of Tennessee Volunteers, raised under the Act of Congress,
approved July 22d, 1861, and do hereby authorize and em=
power him the said John H. Trent to execute and
said office agreeably to Law, and the Rules and
Regulations of the United States in the powers, privi=
leges and emoluments thereunto of right appertaining.

And he is hereby required To obey all the lawful orders and commands of his superior
Officers, and all Officers and Privates under his command are to be alike obedient to him.

In Testimony Whereof, I, ANDREW JOHNSON,

Governor of the State of Tennessee, and Commander-in-Chief of the forces thereof,
have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed,
at the Department in Nashville, on this the Twelfth day
of February Anno Domini, 1863.
